



 10)
- Semester 1 Career Tech students
- Students who rely on district transportation

Students Who May Arrive by 9:27 AM

- Students not enrolled in a Keystone-tested course
- Students with alternate transportation who do not need to be at school for a morning commitment


RIVER BARRY TO PERFORM AT THE HIGH SCHOOL JANUARY 23, 2026
