HENRY COUNTY R-I SCHOOL DISTRICT, MISSOURI BOARD OF EDUCATION

RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 7, 2020

WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Henry County R-I School District, Missouri (the "District") does now find and determine that in order to meet the District's capital improvement needs, it is necessary to borrow a sum of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) and to issue bonds (the "Bonds") of the District for the payment of that loan; and

WHEREAS, the amount of Bonds now proposed to be issued under the Proposition hereinafter set forth, to-wit: of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000), together with the present indebtedness of the District, if any, will not exceed fifteen percent (15 %) of the value of the taxable, tangible property of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board does now further find and determine that it is desirable that the proposal for the issuance of the Bonds be submitted to the qualified electors of the District at the election to be called and held on April 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Board does now further determine that L.J. Hart & Company shall provide municipal bond underwriting services to the District for the issuing of the Bonds in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE HENRY COUNTY R-I SCHOOL DISTRICT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That an election be and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held within the District, on Tuesday, the 7th day of April, 2020 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the District the following proposition, to-wit:

PROPOSITION GREYHOUNDS

Shall the Board of Education of the Henry County R-I School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds betterment of school facilities including, without limitation: to complete safety and security upgrades; to increase energy efficiency through replacement of roofs and heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems; to complete electrical upgrades; to expand the agriculture program; to the extent funds are available, completion of other repairs and improvements to existing facilities of the district; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School

District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.5000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

SECTION 2. That the election shall be held and conducted by the County Clerks of Henry, Benton, Johnson and Pettis Counties, Missouri, under the general election laws governing those Counties on Tuesday, the 7th day of April, 2020, at the polling places designated, or hereafter designated for each precinct in the District by order or orders of the County Clerks of Henry, Benton, Johnson and Pettis Counties, Missouri, and that the polls of the election shall be opened and kept open on that day during the hours required by law.

SECTION 3. That as required by law, the election shall be conducted by the judges and clerks appointed or to be appointed by the County Clerks of Henry, Benton, Johnson and Pettis Counties, Missouri, and that the County Clerks of Henry, Benton, Johnson and Pettis Counties, Missouri shall supply the judges and clerks with all necessary ballot boxes, ballots, poll books, tally sheets, and other supplies required for the conduct of the election, and that the ballot be used in voting upon the proposition shall be in substantially the following form, to-wit:

PROPOSITION GREYHOUNDS

Shall the Board of Education of the Henry County R-I School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds betterment of school facilities including, without limitation: to complete safety and security upgrades; to increase energy efficiency through replacement of roofs and heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems; to complete electrical upgrades; to expand the agriculture program; to the extent funds are available, completion of other repairs and improvements to existing facilities of the district; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.5000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
