The second straight year TVUSD students have outperformed peers in Arizona assessments.

TUCSON, Arizona - The Arizona Department of Education (ADE) officially released letter grades for all Arizona schools. For the second year in a row, all schools in Tanque Verde Unified School District received “A” letter grades. This distinction affirms the collective commitment from our students, families, and staff to achieve high standards of excellence and integrity. The four Tanque Verde schools include Agua Caliente Elementary, Tanque Verde Elementary, Emily Gray Junior High and Tanque Verde High.

The A-F School Letter Grades are the accountability model used by the State to identify school performance. The State Board of Education develops annual achievement profiles for every public school in the state. The criteria for school letter grades involves measuring academic growth, proficiency in English language arts, math, and science and indicators of high school, college and career readiness.

Today’s announcement reflects TVUSD’s core value of excellence for and by every student, every day. While only a snapshot in time, the results are an important data point for TVUSD as we continue to provide the academic environment where respect, collaboration and student achievement are the priority.
