Prior to Exam Day

- Get a good night's rest before your exam and eat a nutritious breakfast.
- Hybrid & Digital exams: Log into Bluebook with your College Board credentials before exam day. Reset password, if necessary. IMPORTANT-memorize your login/password as Bluebook will not allow you to access saved passwords.
- IF YOU WILL NOT BE TAKING THE AP EXAM, notify Stacie Willson ASAP at swillson@smjuhsd.org or scan the AP Exam Change Form QR code. If it's within 24 hours of your exam, text me at 707-337-3335 so we don't wait for you on test day.

Exam Day

- → You are required to arrive 30 minutes prior to your exam: 7:30 a.m. for morning exams and 11:30 a.m. for afternoon exams. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED AFTER THE EXAM BEGINS. Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP exam obligation and make arrangements accordingly.
- → You are allowed (and encouraged) to bring a snack and drink for your 10-minute break. However, morning snacks will be provided and students taking afternoon exams (checking in at 11:30) will receive a sack lunch.
- → Bring a sweater/sweatshirt as it can get cold in the testing room.
- → Bring your government-issued (driver's license) or school-issued photo ID.
- → You may wear a watch that is <u>not a Smartwatch</u> in case your exam room does not have a clock that you can see easily.
- → If applicable, bring your College Board SSD Student Accommodation Letter which verifies that you have been approved for extended time or another testing accommodation.
- → You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Righetti High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam score.

BRING the following items:

for FULLY DIGITAL exams:

(AP Environmental Science, AP US Government, AP US History)

- ☑ Fully charged school-issued laptop and charging cord.
- ☑ **Pencils or pens** for taking notes on school-provided scratch paper.
- ▼ For AP Environmental Science Exams: up to two approved calculators with the necessary capabilities. Visit apstudents.org/calculators for course specific calculator policy. PLEASE NOTE: The school will have calculators available if you have a last-minute issue with yours but will not have enough on hand for all students.

for HYBRID DIGITAL exams:

(AP Calculus AB/BC, AP Chemistry, AP Microeconomics, AP Physics, AP Statistics)

- ☑ Fully charged school-issued laptop and charging cord.
- ☑ Two sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for completing multiple-choice answer sheets.
- ☑ **Two pens with black or dark blue ink only** for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- For AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Microeconomics, Physics, or Statistics Exam: up to two approved calculators with the necessary capabilities. Visit apstudents.org/calculators for course specific calculator policy. PLEASE NOTE: The school will have calculators available if you have a last-minute issue with yours but will not have enough on hand for all students.
- ☑ For AP Physics Exam: a ruler or straightedge. (Protractors are not allowed.)

* for STANDARD (PAPER) exams:

(AP Spanish Language, AP Spanish Literature)

- ☑ Two sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for completing multiple-choice answer sheets.
- ☑ **Two pens with black or dark blue ink only** for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.



DO NOT bring the following to the exam room*:

- Electronic equipment of any kind (except for devices being used for digital AP Exams). The following items are PROHIBITED: phones, smartwatches, smart glasses or wearable technology of any kind, laptops, tablet computers, Bluetooth devices, portable listening or recording devices (MP3 player, iPod, etc.) cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the Internet, separate timers of any type, and any other electronic or communication devices.
- * All stylus pens, Apple pens, smart pens, iPad pencils, and other electronic writing instruments.
- ✗ Books, notebooks, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.*
- * Mechanical pencils, No. 3 pencils, or colored pencils.
- * Rulers or straightedges (allowed only for Physics exams).
- Protractors.
- * Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets or on scratch paper provided by the proctor).
- ➤ Computers or Calculators (except as noted above). See <u>apstudents.collegeboard.org/exam-policies-guidelines/calculator-policies</u> for course specific calculator policy.
- * Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- * Watches that beep or have an alarm.
- **x** Clothing or shoes with subject-related information.
- **X NEW**: Head coverings (hats, brimmed caps, etc.) are not permitted while testing. Head coverings worn for medical or religious reasons are permitted during testing provided they do not obstruct the testing staff's ability to view the test taker's eyes and ears.
- ➤ Ear plugs or headphones.



- × Clipboards.
- * Privacy screens or separate computer monitors.

*Unless an item has been preapproved as accommodation by the College Board Services for Students with Disabilities office prior to the exam date.

A student observed with any prohibited items during testing or breaks may be dismissed from the exam, the items may be confiscated, the student's score may be cancelled, and no retest may be permitted.
