## SCHOOL DAY INFORMATION

Here is some basic information regarding the 2021-2022 school year:

- School will start at 8:30am
- School will end at 3:30pm (SMS) 3:35pm (SHS) Monday-Friday and 2:30pm (SMS) 2:35pm (SHS) Wednesdays
- Please have your student dress warmly as windows will be open during class to help with air circulation.
- Parent drop off and pick up is on the East/Mountain side of the building. Please pull up as far as possible in the drop off lane and then pull over to the curb. This will allow for an efficient flow and keeps the through lanes unobstructed for other vehicles.

## STUDENT MEDICATIONS

## STUDENT DAILY SCREENING

## SPORTS PHYSICALS
