

Online Classes through Virtual School

To view on-line courses available visit <http://sdvs.k12.sd.us>. Click on the **Students/Parents** tab and select **Courses**. This allows you to browse by subject area. Please note:

- *Clark School District will pay for 2 virtual courses per school year
- *If a student does not complete the course or earns less than a "C," the student must reimburse the school \$150.00
- *To qualify for virtual classes a student must have a GPA of 2.6 and currently passing all classes
- *Written approval of parent/guardian and administrator/counselor is required

Dual Credit Courses

Dual credit courses offer Juniors and Seniors the opportunity to receive high school and college credit simultaneously, thereby getting an idea of what college coursework is like, as well as getting a "jump start" on college. Please note:

- *Strict eligibility requirements set by the S.D. Board of Regents is adhered to
- *Cost is \$48.33 per credit hour (Clark School District will contribute \$60 per school year to the cost of a student's dual credit courses)
- *If a student does not complete the course or earns less than a "C," the student must reimburse the school any costs incurred
- *Grades for dual credit courses are weighted in figuring a student's overall GPA
- *Grades are part of the student's permanent record for both high school AND college
- *Written approval of parent/guardian and administrator/counselor is required
