1. Call To Order

The meeting was called to order by Mike Cole, Chair

The following Fannin County Governmental Boards were present with a quorum: the Fannin County School System, the Fannin County Board of Commissioners, the City of Morganton, the City of McCaysville, and the City of Blue Ridge.

2. "INTENT TO OPT OUT OF HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION" (HB 581)

Fannin County Tax Assessor's Office Chief Appraiser Dawn Cochran reiterated the presentation she made during the first public hearing on 1/15/2025 and the second public hearing on 1/22/2025.

She explained the intent of House Bill 581 which went into effect on January 1, 2025. This legislation created a floating homestead exemption for all local governments. Those governmental agencies that do not wish to participate must opt out. Ms. Cochran reviewed current tax exemptions available to the residents of Fannin County and reviewed current and historical Millage rate data emphasizing that local property taxes originate predominately from residential parcels. Ms. Cochran reviewed a provision in HB581 that allows for governmental entities to consider a 1% FLOST (Floating Local Option sales tax) to help recover taxes that

would be lost from the homestead exemption. However, school systems are not eligible to participate in the FLOST. In conclusion, Ms. Cochran commended past and present government servants who have made decisions that were best for the county.

3. Public Comment

The County Commissioners facilitated public comment. Three individuals spoke.

4. Adjourn

There being no further business to come before the meeting, a motion and a second were made to adjourn subject to being called into special session by Chair when deemed necessary.
