The Girls started the season winning 6 of the first 7 duals, losing to Salem/Cambridge in the League Championship Dual 43-11. They lost their last 2 duals of the season, with injuries playing a role. The team had 3 girls as Place Finishers in the Section 2 NY State Qualifiers at Guilderland HS.

We had 8 students on the Nordic team this year. Two in 8 th grade, 2 in 10th, 3 in 11 th and 1 in 12th. A ninth was unable to participate due to his basketball schedule. Our first day of practice for varsity was on 24NOV. The two modified students started on 25NOV25. The first day we were able to ski was 2DEC24. We were able to practice on snow a total of 30 times during the season. All athletes showed great improvement in technique and results as the season progressed. 4 out of the 8 were total beginners and as snow time increased, they all greatly improved. The modified and begginer skiers competed in the shorter courses while I had 4 compete in the varsity on certain courses. The Gore course is extremely challenging, and I entered no one on the harder course there that was unable to handle it. We had no problems maintaining social distancing as most of our time was spent outdoors. Sickness only impacted on the two modified skiers for a week, while a few other practices had to be missed by others. We ended up having to run/hill bound 3 times, 6 weight room workouts and 1 video technique session. Snow, while slow to start, was challenging at times this year but we still managed 10 days of skiing more this year than 2023-24 and eight more than 2021-22 despite a week shorter season. The Gore ski bowl once again proved to be a reliable facility to hold races and luckily Lapland Lake in Benson had good snow for our scheduled events. We were able to have good practice skiing at the Bend of The River and the Saratoga Biathlon Club. Our season completed at section 2 championships where Haley Potavin finished in 24 th place out of 45 and Marius Cateline finished 24 th also out of 41 competitors.



The season's goals included demonstrating better sportsmanship and improving team dynamics. Progress was made in both areas. The team's final record this season was 4-16.
