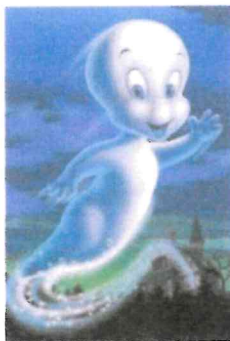




NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

Space is limited and is on a first come first serve basis.

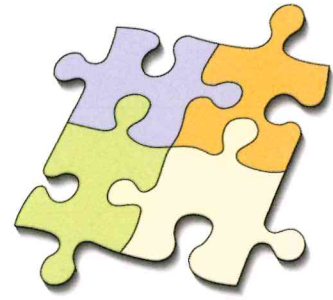
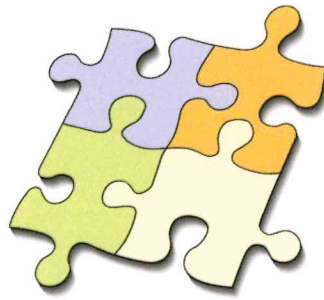
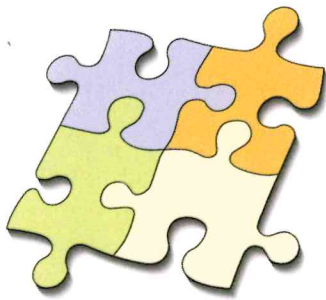
Dismissal will be in the school parking lot outside the extended care door.
