- Backpack - no wheels
- 7 Plastic school box with a latch
- 4 pencils, sharpened
- 1 Headphones for computer class - Please put in a Ziploc bag with name on it.

- Pointed child scissors

- 1 binder - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to 2 "

The binder should be durable enough to last the whole year. We recommend the Mead 5 -star, or any cloth/poly type. The ones with zippers can be especially useful. It is fine to get a standard binder, but if you buy a durable one, you will be able to use it again in $7^{\text {th }}$ grade. If you bought one in $5^{\text {th }}$ grade, feel free to use that one again.

ㅁ 6-3-hole punched folders that will fit in the binder I recommend the poly type folders because they do not rip as easily at the binder rings. The pronged folders cannot be used.

■ 2 notebooks (1 subject): Journal - Yellow, Math - Blue

- Pencils and Erasers
- Pens
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Glue Stick
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Pack of highlighters (such as yellow, pink, blue, green, and orange)

## $7^{\text {th }}$ Grade Supply List

*You should purchase your own planner, or see Mrs. Sherbrooke for sheets, digital options, or other ideas that may work for you.

7th grade students will be taught the skills to be organized the first few days of school in English class. In order to do that, each $7^{\text {th }}$ grade student must have:

ㅁ 1-1\&1/2 inch to $\mathbf{2}$ inch binder
The binder should be durable enough to last the whole year. We recommend the Mead 5 -star, or any cloth/poly type. The ones with zippers can be especially useful. It is fine to get a standard binder, but you may end up needing to replace it within the year.

- 6-different 3 hole punched folders that will fit in the binder Poly type folders are recommended because they do not rip as easily. Do not label or write on any folders. Thin folders can be 3 -hole punched if need. Pronged folders cannot be used.
- 1 - pencil box or bag to keep in locker for supplies (a large Ziploc works)

ㅁ 2 - packages loose leaf paper, wide ruled or college ruled.
ㅁ 1-BASIC calculator (\$1 type). Scientific calculators are not used in $7^{\text {th }}$ grade.

## And

- Pencils (standard or mechanical with extra lead)
- Erasers (often pink)
- Hi-liters (2 colors)
- Colored Pencils (minimum 10 in box)

ㅁ Bag/backpack

*You should purchase your own planner, or see Mrs. Sherbrooke for sheets, digital options, or other ideas that may work for you.

Each $8^{\text {th }}$ grade student must have:

- Pencils

ㅁ 3-ring Binder (1 $1 / 2$ in to 2 in ) plus loose leaf paper.
OR
ㅁ 2 notebooks - 3- to 5- subject plus a 1" 3-ring binder for English class only.
If their $7^{\text {th }}$ grade binder is still useable, I will give them bonus points in class for being green!

- 2 to 6 - different 3-hole punched folders.

Get at least 2 folders. One will be used in the binder required for English class. 1 folder for each class is highly recommended.

ㅁ 1 - pencil box or bag for supplies
ㅁ 1 - calculator. Scientific calculators may be used $8^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ grade
And

If their $8^{\text {th }}$ grade binder is still useable, I will give them bonus points in class for being green!
ㅁ 2 to 6 - different 3-hole punched folders.
Get at least 2. One will be used in the binder required for English class. 1 folder for each class is highly recommended.
- 1 - pencil box or bag for supplies

ㅁ 1 - calculator. Scientific calculators may be used $8^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ grade

## *You should purchase your own planner, or see Mrs. Sherbrooke for sheets, digital options, or other ideas that may work for you.

Each $10^{\text {th }}$ grade student must have:

- Pencils

ㅁ 3-ring Binder ( $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in to 2 in ) with plenty of loose-leaf paper.
OR
ㅁ 2 notebooks - 3 - to 5 - subject

- plus a 1 in 3-ring binder for English class only.

If their $9^{\text {th }}$ grade binder is still useable, I will give them bonus points in class for being green!
ㅁ 2 to 6 - different 3-hole punched folders.
Get at least 2. One will be used in the binder required for English class. 1 folder for each class is highly recommended.

- 1 - pencil box or bag for supplies

ㅁ 1 - calculator. Scientific calculators may be used $8^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ grade
Graphing calculators are only used in advanced math classes - if you are not sure what you'll need, ask your teacher before buying.

- Compass (for geometry)
- Protractor (for geometry)

Optional:
$\square$ Pens - only black/blue pens are permitted for assignments
