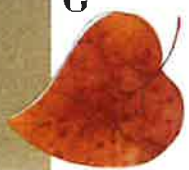

RUSD Parent Faculty Clubs 4th annual **Color Run** will be on Main Street Day, Saturday the 21st at 8 am.

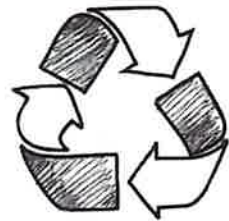


Colony Oak is in need of 2-3 parent volunteers to throw colors at the event
