3	To amend Section 16-22-16, Code of Alabama 1975,
4	relating to the employment of registered nurses in public
5	schools.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
7	Section 1. Section 16-22-16, Code of Alabama 1975,
8	is amended to read as follows:
9	" §16-22-16.
10	"(a) The State Board Department of Education and the
11	Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind shall require the
12	employment of registered school nurses in each local school
13	system, contingent on funding in the Education Trust Fund
14	annual budget act, for each of the following fiscal years and
15	ratios and major fractions thereof:.
16	"(1) 1999-2000 - A minimum of one nurse for every
17	school system.
18	" (2) 2000-2001 - A minimum of one nurse for every
19	7,000 pupils.
20	"(3) 2001-2002 - A minimum of one nurse for every
21	6,500 pupils.
22	" (4) 2002-2003 - A minimum of one nurse for every
23	6,000 pupils.
24	"(5) 2003-2004 - A minimum of one nurse for every
25	5,500 pupils.

Τ	" (6) 2004-2005 - A minimum of one nurse for every
2	5,000 pupils.
3	" (7) 2005-2006 - A minimum of one nurse for every
4	4,500 pupils.
5	" (8) 2006-2007 - A minimum of one nurse for every
6	4,000 pupils.
7	" (9) 2007-2008 - A minimum of one nurse for every
8	3,500 pupils.
9	" (10) 2008-2009 - A minimum of one nurse for every
10	3,000 pupils.
11	"(11) 2009-2010 - A minimum of one nurse for every
12	2,500 pupils.
13	" (12) 2010-2011 - A minimum of one nurse for every
14	2,000 pupils.
15	"Thereafter, a minimum of one registered nurse shall
16	be employed for each 2,000 pupils and major fraction thereof.
17	"(b) Determining the number of pupils for the
18	purpose of allotting school nurses shall be based on pupils in
19	average daily membership during the first two scholastic
20	months of the preceding scholastic year.
21	" (c) Nurses employed exclusively from federal funds
22	shall not be considered in the ratios as required by this
23	section. Nurses employed with local funds are to be included
24	in the ratios as required by this section.

1	"(b) There shall not be greater than five licensed			
2	practical nurses to one registered nurse within each school			
3	system. However, based upon individual circumstances,			
4	including specific medical needs and tasks which must be			
5	performed by a registered nurse as set forth in the Nurse			
6	Practice Act and the Administrative Code rules of the Alabama			
7	Board of Nursing, there may be a lower registered nurse to			
8	licensed practical nurse ratio within each school system.			
9	"(c) The allotment of school nurses shall be			
10	distributed so that each school system shall receive one			
11	registered nurse and an additional nurse or nurses or fraction			
12	of a nursing allocation based upon the average daily			
13	membership during the first 20 scholastic days after Labor Day			
14	of the preceding school year.			
15	"(d) Each local school superintendent shall			
16	designate one registered nurse for the entire school system			
17	whose responsibilities shall include annually providing a full			
18	and comprehensive assessment of all student health needs			
19	within that system. Based upon the assessment findings, the			
20	designated nurse shall make a recommendation to the local			
21	school superintendent concerning the implementation and			
22	coordination of student health needs.			
23	"(d) (e) The State Board Department of Education			
24	shall employ a School Nurse Consultant, who shall be a			
25	registered nurse, to provide supervision of programs statewide			

1	and implement school nursing programs as established by the			
2	State Board of Education.			
3	"(e) There shall be (f) At a minimum, all school			
4	nurses shall be paid according to the statewide salary			
5	schedule for school nurses which shall be included in the			
6	annual budget act for the public schools.			
7	"(f) (g) The amounts necessary to meet the			
8	requirements of this section shall be appropriated in the			
9	annual budget act for the public schools and in the annual			
10	budget act for the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind. The			
11	funding for this requirement is contingent upon available			
12	revenue in the Education Trust Fund and appropriation by the			
13	Legislature.			
14	"(h) Funding provisions of the School Nurses Act			
15	shall be met once every public school in Alabama has a school			
16	nurse and a ratio of one state-funded school nurse for every			
17	500 pupils exists statewide.			
18	" (g) <u>(i)</u> This section is cumulative and shall be			
19	construed in pari materia with other laws, but to the effect			
20	that this section specifically conflicts with other laws in			
21	direct conflict with this section, then those laws or parts of			
22	laws are hereby repealed."			
23	Section 2. This act shall become effective			
24	immediately following its passage and approval by the			

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
