Discipline Policy

Break Detention: A checkmark by any teacher constitutes a loss of break.

After-school Detention:

- a. Three break detentions constitutes a warning sent home to be signed that the NEXT break detention will result in an after-school detention.
- b. Upon the fourth break detention, the loss of break will take place and in addition after-school detention will be served.
- c. Break detention records will be cleared at the beginning of each six-weeks.
- d. Upon earning the third after-school detention, the student will be suspended for at least one day. (The 3rd after-school detention will not be served, just the suspension)
- e. The after-school detention record will be cleared at the beginning of the NEXT semester. (Exception: the 8th grade trip policy; see below)

Suspension:

- a. Suspension will be served based on preceding policy of accumulated after-
- b. Suspension will be earned for any violation of discipline code as outlined in Perry County Discipline policy.

8th Grade Trip Policy:

Upon receiving notice of and serving the third suspension OF THE YEAR, the student will NOT be allowed to participate on the 8th grade trip.
