These programs have been essential to the system in the past years in increasing student learning. Now they are more important as we have faculty/staff that can focus only on these areas and take some responsibility off of everyday classroom teacher. Elba City Schools takes all barriers very serious and as barriers arise we will handle them as quickly as possible. We we address the learning loss for all groups including each major racial and ethnic group, children from low-income families, children with disabilities, English Learners, gender, migrant students, students experiencing homelessness, and children and youth in foster care.

* Elba City Schools utilized scores from the students performance on AimsWeb Plus, Spire, Renaissance Learning as well as evaluating grades from the previous year while meeting with both teachers and parents on the subject of determining a decision on students status.

* Elba City Schools is currently all in-person learning. Our in-person learning even when virtual/hybrid was offered was never a large percentage. However, due to the quarantine regulations some of our students did miss a large amount of in-person learning. Therefore, we have looked at any scores, including grades from the past two years to determine any students that may need to be identified to benefit from the new opportunities provided these funds. We were one of the only systems that had our doors open for in-person instruction the entire school year of 2020-2021 and provided virtual/online learning for students that were sick or quarantined.

ARP ESSER funds will be used to host a Summer Enrichment Camp during the Summer of 2023. The camp will run for two weeks for four days a week. Subjects to be covered are science, technology, engineering, mathematics and reading. We will purchase general supplies such as pencils, notebooks, glue, color pencils, copy paper, etc. to effectively run the program. We will also purchase ELA & Math manipulatives to help improve student achievement. Additionally, we will purchase an online subscription to XYZ Company for the duration of the summer program to assist our participating EL students with the curriculum (See attached job description). Total cost: \$109,030.00

Elba City Schools will provide after school learning opportunities during the 2022-2023 school year to continue help mitigate the loss of learning during these COVID times. We will provide this funding for 1.5 teachers at a rate of \$40 per hour for 2.5 hours a day and 163 days a year. This portion of funding will help cover 1.5 teachers for this section of funding. Services will end 9/30/2024.

1.5 teachers

The cost below will cover 7 teachers to work the summer programs. Services will end 9/30/2024.
