Helpful Hints

Blends- 2 consonants that stand together and each consonant makes its sound. These are the /Blends: bl, cl, fl, gl, pl, sl.

Some vowel sounds change when vowels are followed by a double l in single-syllable words.

The -all has a short o sound: call, fall, mall.

The -oll has a long o sound: roll, toll, troll (exceptions are doll and lol).

The -ull has two different sounds; it has the sounds of short u and oo, as in look; gull versus pull; dull versus bull.
