2024 Graduation Dress Code and Information

Ladies:

- If your dress or pants will show below your gown, then the color must be blue or black.
- Shoes must be black, brown, white, or nude. No tennis shoes, flip-flops, Birkenstocks, Crocs, Chacos, Tevas, or excessively high heels.
- Avoid large earrings and flashy accessories.

Gentleman:

- White or oxford light blue collared dress shirt
- Red or navy tie or bowtie
- Blue, black, or khaki dress pant. No jeans.
- Black or brown dress shoes. No tennis shoes, flip-flops, Birkenstocks, Crocs, Chacos, or Tevas. Boots are acceptable if they are clean.

This is a formal ceremony and should be treated as such regarding appearance and behavior.

Caps and gowns:

- Please hang up your gown and let the wrinkles fall out naturally. Do not iron these. You can, however, steam them if needed.
- Do not decorate your graduation cap.
- Please take as many pictures ahead of time or after the ceremony because only graduates will be permitted in the ballroom (holding room) upon arrival.

Stoles, honor cords, and medals:

- Only stoles, honor cords, and medals approved by LHS can be worn at the graduation ceremony.
- The following are approved: red satin LHS stole, white satin honor graduate stole, military stole or cord, graduate of special distinction medal, National Merit medal, 30+ ACT medal, MS Scholars medal, National Honor Society stole, English honor society cord, Mu Alpha Theta cord, Spanish National Honor Society cord, National Technical Honor Society cord, German Honor Society cord, International Thespian Society cord, SYLC cord, Red Cross blood drive cord, BETA cord, Quill and Scroll cord, Chemistry cord.

Dates to remember:

- Thursday, May 16- 7:30-**mandatory** senior breakfast (for graduates only), cap and gown distribution, and walk through--Dress code: dressy casual; wear a college shirt, employer shirt, or senior jersey! (*Parents can decorate seniors' cars during the breakfast. Parents and guests will be permitted to watch the senior walk from Patriot Drive between LIS and LHS.*)
- Thursday, May 16- 1pm- **mandatory** Graduation practice at the Landers Center- graduates only (*If you are not present, you will not be permitted to walk at graduation that night.*) Be in your seat at 12:50pm. Roll will be called at 12:50; rehearsal starts at 1pm.
- Sunday, May 19- 3pm- Graduation at the Landers Center- graduates will need to be present in the ballroom (holding room) no later than 2:00pm (doors will open at 1:30pm).
- Once the graduation ceremony is finished, you will pick up your diploma upstairs in the ballroom. **Please do not leave without your diploma.**
