★ Your report must include:

1. Character Traits

- Identify and explain at least three major personality traits.
- Use direct quotes and scenes from the novel to support your observations.

2. Motivations & Goals

- What does your character want most?
- How do their desires drive the plot?

3. Relationships

- Discuss how this character interacts with at least two other characters.
- What do these relationships reveal about them?

4. Symbolism

- o Identify any symbols (objects, places, or actions) associated with this character.
- Explain their deeper meaning.

5. Theme Connection

• How does this character help develop one of the novel's central themes (e.g., the American Dream, wealth and class, illusion vs. reality)?

Personal Letter from the Character

- Use language that matches the character's voice and personality.
