Back to School Reminders:

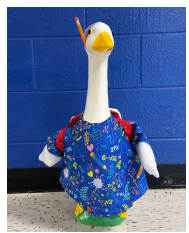
- Your child is tardy after 7:50.

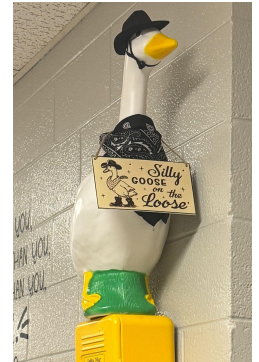
