Mrs. Boswell's Math, Science, and History Policies and Procedures

Grades

Math:

Major: 65% (tests & projects)

Minor: 35% (quizzes, in-class assignments, & homework)

Science & History:

Major: 65% (tests, projects, & labs)

Minor: 35% (quizzes & in-class assignments)

Math

Students will learn decimal arithmetic, fraction arithmetic, integers, ordering rational numbers, ratios, rates, percents, coordinate plane, expressions, equations, inequalities, geometry, data, and statistics. We will take notes on each topic, practice each topic with activities and daily work, and quiz and test on each topic. Videos will be placed in google classroom that reviews the notes for each topic. These can be used for help with homework or if the student was absent that day. Homework is typically given Monday – Thursday. Generally homework will be 10 problems or less. Homework is checked for completion <u>WITH</u> shown work. The homework grade starts off as a 100, and each time it is incomplete, it takes off 5 points off their homework grade. Homework will make up no more than 5% of students' grades. Consequences will be given for incomplete or missing homework. Ex. silent snack.

Science

Students will learn about Earth's Processes and Systems. This includes rocks, weather, space/astronomy, oceans, tectonic plates, earthquakes, and volcanoes. This year we will be using AMSTI science and will have multiple hands-on labs to learn the processes and systems of Earth. I am excited to get started! Students will have homework in science only if they do not complete the in class assignments for that day. They will be expected to have it completed by the following day.

History

In Social Studies students will learn about the 2nd Industrial Revolution to the present day. Students will take notes, in class, complete Escape Rooms, Vocabulary, Graphic Organizers, Projects, and Dress up days. Any power points used in class will be posted on my website and all study guides will be given to students or linked on google classroom.
