We appreciate your interest in volunteering for the Bamberg County School District Chaperone/Volunteer Program. In an effort to ensure the safety of our students, we have implemented additional safety precautions for prospective chaperones/volunteers.

Our district offers a variety of activities you may choose from when volunteering your time. Simply complete and submit a chaperone and volunteer application and upon approval you will receive instructions on the next steps.

Please note the following:

- 1. All chaperones and volunteers must undergo a criminal history screening through the National and South Carolina Sexual Offender Registries prior to approval.
- 2. All chaperones and volunteers must be 18 years of age or older.

It is very important that the information you enter on the application matches your government issued identification card, including your full legal name. It is important that you provide a valid email address so you can be notified as to the status of your application and for future communication. All information collected on the application will remain confidential and will not be shared outside the volunteer program.

Please note that the approval process could take anywhere from two to four weeks. If you have any questions about the application, please contact your school's administration.

General Volunteer Guidelines:

- All chaperones must be at least 18 years of age. (Policy: IJOB/IJOC)
- All volunteers will work with students under the immediate supervision and direction of school personnel.
- Background screening results are evaluated on an individual basis.
- Please arrive on time for a scheduled volunteer opportunity.
- Give school personnel as much notice as possible if you are unable to fulfill your commitment. The scheduled event may need to be altered if a volunteer becomes unavailable.
- Discussion with teachers and other staff should be focused on the volunteer work. Please arrange an appointment for a conference if you need to discuss your child's work, behavior, or progress.
- Discussion regarding students should be limited to the staff member with whom you are working. Confidentiality for our students is very important. Do not speak about specific students or teachers in the community or on social media. If you have an issue with a staff member, please speak with the building principal. If you have concerns about a student, speak with the classroom teacher.
- Report discipline and behavior issues to the teacher.
- Volunteers should speak with school personnel about safety procedures regarding emergency situations.
- Please do not bring other children (students and non-students, including infants and non-school aged children) with you when you are volunteering. Children not enrolled in the class attending a field trip are not permitted to go.
- Volunteers should refrain from using cell phones and other electronic devices during the time they are scheduled to supervise students.
- Volunteers are expected to be role models to students. This includes behavior and attitude, as well as attire, use of language, and use of alcohol/tobacco.
- All chaperones/volunteers must adhere to Bamberg County School District Policies IJOA and IJOA-R during all field trips.
