The Governing Board of the Tanque Verde Unified School District #13, Pima County, Tucson, Arizona held a Regular Session on April 11, 2013 in the Board Room, at the Tanque Verde Unified School District Administrative Office, 2300 N. 2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

MOTION: Mr. Auslander made a motion to approve the Agenda. Mr. Ruiz seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

3. REPORTS

• Student Board Member report –Miss Rachel Dick presented her student Board member report. Past:

At the Race for the Cure, the TVHS National Honor Society won the trophy for the Team with the Greatest Increase in Members.

EGJH raised \$4,718.03 for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. Harris, Stetson, and Nichols earned the bronze pendants raising between \$100-199; Tobias and Pettry earned silver raising between \$200-299; and Stock, Baechler, and Meyer earned gold raising \$300 and up.

The TVHS Band and Choir competed at Disneyland last weekend. The Choir received a rating of Good, the Band an Excellent, the Percussion a Superior, and the Jazz a Superior.

Future:

Powder Puff is coming up at TVHS, with the boys' volleyball game on the 25th and the girls' football game on the 26th.

• Superintendent's Report

Dr. Price shared with the Board the Open Enrollment Lottery went well. Phone calls have been made and letters have been sent. Families were notified they must register their students by Friday, April 19 to secure their spot. We should have a pretty good indication by Monday, April 22 where we are in terms of capacity, and if we should begin calling families on the wait list.

Tanque Verde High is planning an out of state Senior Trip to Disneyland on May 18. This is an overnight out of state trip; however, they will not be staying in a hotel. The formal request will be on the April 25 board agenda for board consideration.

There was a parent information meeting at Tanque Verde Elementary today regarding consideration for the District-Sponsored Charter. The meeting went well; Dr. Price and Mrs. Place spoke with parents and emphasized that the district is only considering this option for budget funding purposes. They also clarified that if the district chose to sponsor a charter there would be no change to the programs at Tanque Verde Elementary, and there would be no impact for the staff.

Dr. Price said he met with Tucson Country Day School, a $K-8^{th}$ grade charter school. They had questions about our Lottery process. They explained our district has become the district of choice for their students and wondered if they could be identified as a feeder school to Tanque Verde High School. Dr. Price suggested they submit a proposal for our consideration. Dr. Price said, in the future, he thinks representatives from Tucson Country Day should be invited to Hawk night, they extended an invitation to Dr. Price to tour their campus as well.

- Enrollment update Mr. O'Shea advised the board that our current enrollment is up. ACES increased by five (5) students, TVES increased by three (3) students, EGJH lost one (1) student, and TVHS lost one (1) student as well.
- **District Report Card** Mr. O'Shea addressed the Board, stating six weeks of school remain. We will carry forward \$50,000 to \$100,000.
- **Legislative update** Mr. Neff stated there is nothing much to report. The State Bar has begun monitoring Legislative activity. We should have a budget by mid-June.
- Facilities report Mr. O'Shea advised the Board Climatec would be reporting tonight. Dr. Price added we have a Memorandum of Agreement with the Church, the park project is progressing. On Saturday, April 27 Boy Scouts, Brad and Rory Albrecht will be working on the green space. Mr. Livingston is designing the irrigation plan, Landscape Architect; Jessie Byrd developed the Landscape design. The Church continues to be supportive and collaborative in development of this green space.

A. Climatec – Energy Audit

Brandon Woodward and Jeff Bartel from Climatec presented a detailed and thorough description of their audit findings on each of the campuses as well as recommended solutions. With our Solar project complete, and fully functioning, solar generates an average of 80% of electric production on each campus; therefore, Climatec is focusing energy efficiency models to improve efficiency on the remaining 20%. Dr. Price and Mr. O'Shea are reviewing the recommendations from Climatec. Dr. Price will present his recommendation to the Board once the review is complete.

B. Charter Resolution –

Mrs. Place talked about creating a clear and concise presentation that covers all the considerations and implications of a District-Sponsored Charter for the Thursday, April 18 meeting. This is to allow the community to hear a consistent message. She added she would like something to be placed on the district website as well. The Board discussed at length, clearly noting, no decision has been made at this time. It is important for everyone to understand the district is only considering this option for budget funding purposes. There would be no change to the programs at Tanque Verde Elementary, and there would be no impact for the staff. IF the district does move forward and establishes a district-sponsored charter for Tanque Verde Elementary, the timing of this decision is crucial. Choosing a charter once the district reaches capacity and receives its final sudden growth funding would be optimal.
