 - Math: 68% (4th) [13% >90%), 64% (5th) [2% >90%), 50% (6th) [3% >90%).
 - Measures are in place for students below grade level to receive Tier 2 or Tier 3 remediation, individually or in small groups.
- K-Prep: We reviewed last year's K-Prep results. David T. Wilson scored better than the State's averages across the board in Reading, Math, Science, and Writing.
