





Do you feel a 4 day school week has positively impacted your student's academic success?




- Yes, a 4 day school week has made a positive impact on my student's academic success.

Academics aside do you feel a 4 day school week has positively impacted your student's mental/emotional well being?




- Yes, a 4 day school week has made a positive impact on my student's mental/emotional well being.

Do you feel less stressed with the day to day tasks of being an educator since starting a 4 day school week?




- Yes, the switch to a 4 day school week has positively impacted me as an educator.

Do you feel attendance has improved since starting a 4 day school week?




- Yes, student attendance has improved since starting the 4 day school week.

With the 4-day week, do you feel lesson quality has improved, or do you feel you have less time to provide adequate instruction?




- The 4 day week model has improved lesson quality
