Graduation Practice

- Thursday, May 23, 2024
- Graduation practice is mandatory for all participants.
- Report to Reaves Arena by <u>9:30 AM</u>, Georgia National Fairgrounds in Perry
- Students should utilize the North Gate parking lot. Enter through the walk-thru at the North Gate entrance.
- Check with Mrs. Brock on the pronunciation of your name.

Graduation

- Report time: 7:00 AM Saturday, May 25
- We will meet to line up in the multipurpose building (behind Reaves Arena)
- Anticipate traffic; allow plenty of time to arrive BEFORE 7:00 AM.
- Check with your row leader for proper lineup.
- Leave phones, purses, valuables with your family; you will not be able to carry these and there is no area for storage.

Ticketing and Venue Information

- Each graduate will receive 10 tickets.
- Each guest will need a ticket for entry.
- Ticket Distribution: May 20, 2024, 3:00-5:00pm *Tickets will only be issued to the graduate, or a parent/guardian listed on Infinite Campus. Please have identification.*
- The program will be livestreamed via the county website.
- No concessions will be open; visitors may have water bottles, but no coolers, balloons, noisemakers, or signs will be permitted.



Cap/Gown Information

- Remove your gown from the bag and hang it up so wrinkles will fall out.
- Don't forget your cap, gown, stole, tassel and any honors cords on graduation day! We do not have extras.
- Cap should be worn straight & level, with tassel to the right. Caps should not be decorated.
- Regalia should be worn as follows:
 - 1. School Stole
 - 2. Honor Stole
 - 3. Honor Cords

Only school related regalia is allowed for graduation.

Graduation Attire for Females

- Solid Dark or Nude shoes
 - No house slippers, flip flops, combat boots, sneakers
- Dresses should not be longer than the hem of your gown. If dress/pants are longer than the gown, they must be solid, dark colors.
 - No shorts



Graduation Attire for Males

- Solid, dark colored dress pants; no jeans or shorts
- Button up dress shirt, dark socks, dark tie/bowtie
- Dark dress shoes
 - No house slippers, flip flops or sneakers

Ceremony Etiquette

- Make sure all gowns and hats are paraphernalia free.
- Remember our Motto: "Excellence is the Standard, not the goal," and the ceremony should reflect our motto.
- Respect the accomplishments of your class.
- Graduation is a dignified, important event for everyone.
- Please review the HCBE graduation decorum letter; a copy will be included with graduation tickets and emailed home to parents.

Graduation Reminders

- Graduation is not complete until recessional is over.
- If you throw your hat and tassel following the graduation ceremony and do not get it back, we will not have an extra to give you.
- On the stage you will receive only the diploma cover.
- If you do not intend to participate in the ceremony, please see your counselor immediately.

Recessional

- Diploma Distribution
 - Row leaders will distribute diplomas to their given rows during departure from Reaves Arena.
 - Be sure to follow row staff guidance and understand distribution directions from graduation practice and during lineup prior to graduation.
