The Conecuh County Board of Education is now accepting applications for the following vacancy:

Mental Health Coordinator

Qualifications:

- Must hold a valid 4 yr. degree, license and/or certificate in Psychology, social work, counseling or mental health area.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Be responsible for coordinating access for student mental health services throughout the local school system.
- Work toward common goals of equity, access, academic, career, and social/emotional growth.
- Be an active partner in school-and system-level Problem Solving Teams (PSTs).
- Implement behavior and foundational wellness activities as part of the LEA's multi-tier system of support.
- Build a sense of community, which serves as a platform to create an environment encouraging the success of all students.
- Facilitate policies and practices that create and maintain a safe, supportive, and effective learning environment.
- Assist students in making transitions from grade to grade and to postsecondary opportunities.
- Assist with the selection, development, and implementation of individual evidence-based interventions and behavior plans.
- Coordinate mental health intervention supports to individuals and small groups.
- Provide professional development and parent education.
- Advocate for the rights of students.
- Team with other school-based mental health professionals and other mental health providers for student services.
- Consult with parents, school staff, administrators, and other stakeholders.
- Provide crisis prevention and intervention.
- Identify, refer to, and utilize community resources.
- Incorporate a program to enhance students' foundational wellness skills (e.g., character education, motivation, goal-setting, conflict resolution, suicide and bullying prevention, and resilience).
- Connect students and their families with community organizations, and services.
- Develop and/or support student mentoring programs (e.g., existing school, community, LEA, state, or federal mentoring programs).
- Monitor the progress of individual students and members of various school subgroups.

- Conduct and analyze ongoing formative and summative evaluation data to determine the program's effectiveness.
- Provide and submit reports as requested to the school, LEA central office, and/or ALSDE.
- Other duties as assigned
