Jonathan Saeger is an assistant professor of music at University of Mount Olive where he directs the Concert choir and Chamber Choir. He also teaches Applied Voice and a variety of Music Education courses. Jonathan earned a B.M. in Music Education at Millikin University, an M. M. in Choral Conducting at Illinois State University, and is pursuing a PhD in Music Education at Kent State Universi-

ty. Mr. Saeger comes to the University of Mount Olive after serving on the Choral and Music Education faculty at Western Illinois University. While at WIU, he directed the 60 - voice Concert Choir and the WIU Vocal Jazz Ensemble. Mr. Saeger also served on the faculty at Kent State University where he directed the KSU Women's Chorus and taught music education courses. Jonathan Saeger taught at the middle school and high level in Florida, Illinois, and New Mexico. His choirs have consistently earned superior scores at district and state festivals. He has been an active member of the National Association for Music Education. Jonathan served as the New Mexico Music Education Association District 6 Choral Vice-President. Mr. Saeger has presented at both the Ohio and North Carolina Music Educators Professional Development Conferences. In addition to music education, Mr. Saeger has been an active church musician, serving congregations in Illinois, New Mexico, and Ohio. His choirs have commissioned new choral music and collaborated with other community ensembles to present large masterworks. He has also been a frequent clinician, directing festival choirs in Illinois, and adjudicating choirs, ensembles, and soloists throughout his career. As a soloist, Mr. Saeger has sung with McDonough Choral Society, Quintessence -Choral Artists of the Southwest, and other professional and community ensembles.

High School Clinician



Dr. José Rivera, Associate Professor of Choral Music Education at the University of North Carolina- Pembroke serves as the Coordinator of Music Education and conducts the University Chorale. Prior appointments include University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and director of choral activities at Lawton Chiles High

School and James Rickards High School in Tallahassee, Florida. Dr. Rivera has conducted All-District and Honor Choirs at the district, state, and regional levels. He recently led a performance of the Latin-American Honor Choir *Cantaré at the AC-DA Southern Region Conference and has conducted All-State choirs in North Carolina, Florida, and Alabama. He has guest conducted and presented at the Universidad National Autónoma de Mexico (UNAM) and Universidad de Las Americas (UDLAP) in Mexico, Instituto Superior de las Artes in Cuba, Universidad de Mendoza in Argentina, and the DoDEA High School Chorus Festival in Oberwesel, Germany.*

His research areas include teacher preparation and Global Music with a focus on the music traditions of Latin America and has presented choral clinics and lectures at state, regional, and national American Choral Director Association and the National Association for Music Educators conferences.

Dr. Rivera received his Ph.D, MM.E, and undergraduate degrees in Music Education and Conducting from Florida State University. During his tenure in Florida, he was a successful public music teacher at the elementary, middle, and high school levels where his advanced choirs received various regional and national awards. Dr. Rivera served as ACDA National R&R Chair for World Musics and is currently the NC-ACDA President-elect. He thoroughly enjoys preparing future music educators in North Carolina.
