As we continue through the 2024-25 school year at Vista Grande High School (VGHS), we are simultaneously planning for the 2025-26 school year. 2. A 'Letter of Recommendation' from a community member

a. This can be from a family member, a friend, a former teacher, a supervisor, etc., but it needs to be from someone that **is not a parent/guardian**.
