Dear Parishioners.

As I write this (Tuesday afternoon), I am still anxiously awaiting discussing with the doctors the result of the tests that I had on Monday, which included a EKG and echocardiogram. There is no significant change since May, suggesting that I may fall in the third that experience little change (about a third improve, and the other third experience significant setbacks).

As a result, I will need to go for further consultation, which may include further interventions, and in the meantime continue with the monitor/defibrillator I have worn these last 14 weeks and taking Warfarin. While not the worst thing in the world, the monitor is a nuisance in that it makes sleep and laying down a little uncomfortable, I need to pay attention to the material of shirts I wear (sports shirts when exercising are especially good at messing with the monitor), and I need to remember to take it with me when I don't have the shoulder strap around me (as at night). I am disappointed but am also grateful that I feel as well as I do. In the meantime, I am told to continue exercising as I have.

A few weeks ago, we were notified by the roofing company that the louvers around the steeple at St. Edward's were beyond repair. They will need replacing. The council had already agreed to repair them, and the old ones look tougher than we had realized. We got an estimate of about \$44,000 to remove the entire wood louver system, construct and replace new louvers made of aluminum. These should last a long time and most of us will never have to worry about replacing again. I am waiting for permission from the Diocese to make this extra expense, and it will be covered by the capital campaign.

This last week, the work on the exterior steps at St. Eloi began. This will be a project, as it entails a lot of demolition and removal of debris before even beginning to fill and build up the steps. In the meantime, everyone will have to enter through the new addition doors – please be kind and courteous as we all attempt to leave at the same time.




