

Summer 2024 Chromebook Information



Frazier School District is supporting an effort for all 1st thru 11th grade students to keep their school-issued Chromebook over the summer! Keeping their device promotes student ownership of devices and drastically reduces the amount of instructional time lost to collection and distribution of Chromebooks each year.

Learning Continues: Students are encouraged to use their Chromebooks to pursue academic learning, hobbies, and other passions as long as those pursuits would be appropriate on a school-issued device. Examples include but are not limited to, computer coding, audio-visual production, reading, writing, and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) activities. High school students should also consider using summer months to research colleges, universities and other post graduate opportunities.

Storing the Chromebook: *Even if a student does not intend to use the Chromebook over the summer, we ask families to simply store the device at home.* Doing so guarantees that students will have access to their Chromebook and charger on the very first day of school and avoids potential delays during student registration and schedule pick-up. These devices do not require regular maintenance over the summer and can be safely stored on a shelf with the charger. Additional tips for using and/or storing a Chromebook will be sent home at the end of this school year.

Filters: All content accessed through our Chromebooks will continue to be filtered according to local, state, and federal policies and will remain the property of Frazier School District.

Device damage: Any Chromebook damages that occur between May 30th and the start of the 2024-2025 school year can be repaired through the Technology Department. Please email tech@fraziersd.org to set up an appointment for repair. Any damage that is not repaired over the summer will be repaired in the fall according to the current Chromebook Handbook.

Students are still responsible for damage due to negligence just as they are during the rest of the school year.

Chromebook Insurance for summer of 2024: Students that purchased the optional device protection plan for the 23-24 school year and have **NOT** utilized their two incidents of accidental damage will continue to have damage protection until the first day of 24-25 school year.

Chromebook Insurance for 2024-2025: Frazier School District will hold its 24-25 optional technology protection enrollment period a few weeks before the start of school as usual. This protection plan will cover students for two incidents of accidental damage repairs for the entire 24-25 school year and the summer of 2025. This is an optional program for students in grades 1 thru 12 so students can be covered in the event of accidental damage to their school device. Lost or stolen Chromebooks: A lost or stolen device during the summer should be reported immediately to tech@fraziersd.org or calling 724-736-9507 x129.

Summer transfers: If you are moving out of the Frazier School District during the summer vacation months, you are required to turn in your device and charger, otherwise a charge will be assessed for a full replacement of the device. There are a few options that you can choose from to turn in your device.

- You may return your child's device to Frazier School District administrative office located at the High School, Monday thru Thursday, between the hours of 8am and 4pm.
- Up until May 30th, you may turn in your device at your child's school during regular office hours.

No action is necessary to participate in the Summer Chromebook program. Parents also may choose to not allow their student to keep their Chromebook over the summer. If you would like to opt out of having your student keep their Chromebook over the summer, please use [this form](#).
