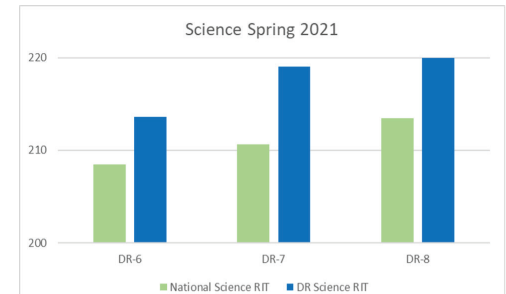
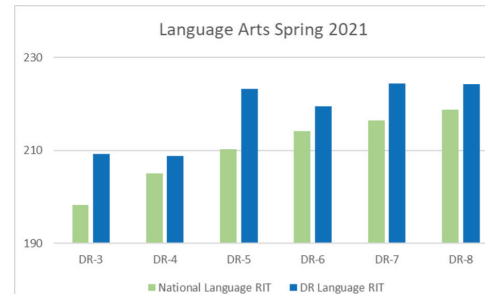
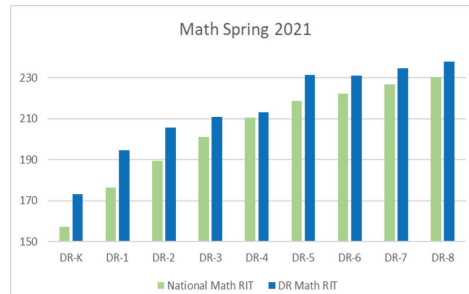
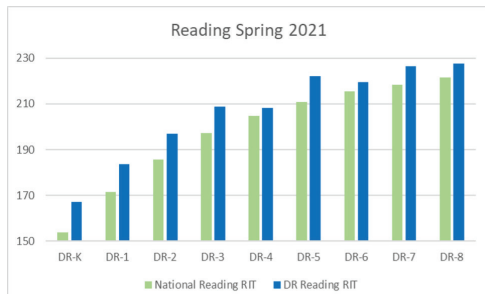
Divine Redeemer Lutheran School, accredited through National Lutheran School Accreditation, presents ample opportunities
