The Fannin County Board of Education met in regular session with the following members present: Bobby Bearden, Chairperson; Lewis DeWeese, Vice-Chairperson; Terry Bramlett; Sandra Mercier; and Steve Stanley. All members present.

By motion of Sandra Mercier, seconded by Terry Bramlett, a unanimous affirmative vote was given to approve the following items on the consent agenda:

Moved, seconded, and carried to approve the financial report for the month ending March 31, 2011. Mark Henson, Superintendent, stated the SPLOST check received in April for the month of February was \$262,317.51.

#### **Public Comment:**

Tim Smith, a member of the 2011 Fannin Leadership class, said he appreciated the tour that school personnel gave his class in March. Mr. Smith stated he was impressed with the technology used in the classrooms.

After public comment, Dr. Michael Gwatney, Director of Technology & Media Services, reviewed the system's three-year technology plan with board members. Dr. Gwatney explained the various types of grants and E-Rate funding received by Fannin County Schools. A requirement of the grant application process is to have a three-year technology plan.

Moved, seconded, and carried to pursue the process of getting lights installed on the Fannin County High School baseball field. Mr. Henson explained this was a project the board had been considering since last year; however, the administration and coaching staff requested the project be delayed until summer so as not to disrupt the existing baseball schedule.

Moved, seconded, and carried to pursue the process of installing HVAC controls for the current wall hung units at Blue Ridge Elementary and East Fannin Elementary schools.

Moved, seconded, and carried to award the bank bid to Community & Southern Bank for a two-year period starting July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2013, at a fixed interest rate of 1.10% for all central office and school nutrition accounts. Principals can make the decision of what bank they want to use for their school.

Moved, seconded, and carried to approve a maximum class size resolution for the 2011 – 2012 school year authorizing an increase in class size from 1 to 3 students in grades K-12 in Regular Education, 1 to 7 students in Gifted, 1 to 3 students in Early Intervention Program (EIP), 1 to 3 students in Remedial Education Program (REP), 1 to 3 students in Vocational (CTAE), and 1 to 3 students in Alternative Education Program (AEP).

Moved, seconded, and carried to hold off bidding propane until September in anticipation of rates lowering. Art Hubbard, Assistant Superintendent, stated the current vendor has agreed to fill the tanks with their old bid price.

Moved, seconded, and carried to approve a resolution pledging to support the work embedded in *A Vision for Public Education: Equity and Excellence* and to determine areas of transformation for our district in continuing efforts to improve educational opportunities for all students.

Moved, seconded, and carried to approve the resignations of Dixie Fitzgerald effective May 27, 2011; Holly Boyd effective June 2, 2011; and Dawn R. Thompson and Miranda Chancey at the end of the 2010 – 2011 school year.

Moved, seconded, and carried to approve Scott Eggleston as a teacher for the 2011 - 2012 school year contingent on his receiving requisite Georgia certification.

Moved, seconded, and carried to approve Kristen Kay and Joshua Snider as teachers and Kathryn Ann George as a visually impaired teacher for the 2011-2012 school year.

#### Superintendent's Comments:

Mr. Henson stated a career fair would be held in the parking lot at Fannin County Middle School on Friday, May 20, 2011. Mr. Henson invited board members to attend.

Mr. Henson reminded board members graduation would be held on Friday, May 27, 2011, at 8:00 p.m. at the Fannin County High School Stadium. The rain date will be Saturday, May 28, 2011, in the Fannin County High Football Stadium at 10:00 a.m. If necessary due to weather, the graduation ceremony will be moved to the new high school gym.

Mr. Henson stated he attended the fifth grade student/parent night transition held at the Fannin County Middle School with his daughter, and he was impressed with the information shared with students and parents.

Mr. Henson asked Karen Walton, Director of Curriculum & School Improvement, to give board members an update on the system's SACS-CASI accreditation status with the AdvanceD Accreditation Commission. Mrs. Walton explained the AdvanceEd Accreditation Commission is the group responsible for SACS-CASI accreditation. Mrs. Walton stated that on February 2, 2011, AdvanceEd Accreditation Commission accepted the accreditation progress report submitted from the school district and granted continuation of the district's accreditation term.

#### Board Members' Comments:

Terry Bramlett thanked Mrs. Walton for sharing the good news about the continuation of the district's accreditation term with SACS-CASI. Mr. Bramlett stated it was exciting to be a part of team of such high-quality performers. Mr. Bramlett commended Dr. Gwatney on his work on the three-year technology plan. Mr. Bramlett thanked Mr. Hubbard for his assistance in getting so many construction projects completed over the past six years. Mr. Bramlett recognized that the end of the school year was stressful and encouraged all staff to finish strong.

Steve Stanley congratulated senior students and their parents for their upcoming graduation. Mr. Stanley stated he was proud of their accomplishments, and he looked forward to seeing them at graduation.

Lewis DeWeese stated he appreciated all of the work school employees put into this school year being a good, safe, uneventful year at the worst of financial times.

Bobby Bearden thanked Art Hubbard for all he does for the school system. Mr. Bearden stated he was pleased with the new lighting that has been installed in the schools. Mr. Bearden stated he is excited about the improvements the cafeteria renovation project at the high school will make. Mr. Bearden asked Dr. Gwatney to share with all of the technology personnel present at the work session on Tuesday his appreciation for a job well done. Mr. Bearden stated he attended his first trout release earlier in the day, and it was a wonderful experience. Mr. Bearden stated he was pleased to have Mrs. Mericer as part of the board.

Sandra Mercier stated she was pleased the Fannin County School System was currently not having to consider furloughs and reduction in salaries like some of the neighboring school boards. Mrs. Mercier commended Ms. Jackson, as well as Mr. Henson and Mr. Hubbard, for the efficiency and competency of the financial management of the system. Mrs. Mercier stated she was excited with the GHSGT test scores: 200 out of 208 students passed English, 199 out of 208 passed science, 172 out of 208 passed math, and 85% passed social studies. Mrs. Mercier stated scores like this made her proud to be a part of the board and school system.

There being no further business to come before the board, upon motion duly made, seconded, and carried, the meeting adjourned subject to being called into special session by the chairman when deemed necessary.
