



Welcome to Academy Prep Tampa

I want to welcome you as APT School Wellness and Federal Meals Coordinator. My role is to work with you and your child to ensure a smooth and healthy transition to Academy Prep Tampa. I am here to assist with any questions or concerns. By working together, we can ensure a healthy and safe school year for every student.

STUDENTS WILL BE SENT HOME FOR:

- If their temperature is **99.5 or higher**
 - If they are **actively vomiting**
 - If they have **diarrhea**
- If they need to be seen by a physician
- If the school nurse feels it is in their best interest

Important to know:

- Epi-pens, Albuterol, Benadryl, Tylenol, or Cough Drops cannot be supplied by the school. Medications of any type, even over the counter medications, should never be brought to school by the child. We ask the parent to please bring medications to the clinic.
- A Parental Authorization for Administration of Medication Form must be completed by parent/ guardian for each medication. (Please click on the link to complete)

- A Doctor's signature on all Care Plans and medication forms for prescription medications is required for all medications that will be given for longer than a two-week period.

- Food allergies of any kind are not recognized by our cafeteria staff unless we have a Food Allergy Action Plan signed by a doctor. Please, ask your doctor, NP, PA for the Food Allergy Action Plan, if not provided email lberrios@academyprep.org or call (813) 248-5600 to request a copy for your provider to complete it.
- Please keep our staff and the school nurse informed of any health conditions that could affect your child while at school.
- It is important that you understand that if your student presents or develops symptoms of illness during school hours and/or school activities, they will be required to wear the protective mask until their symptoms improve.
- Students must be fever free (99.5 degrees or greater) for 24 hours without use of fever reducing medicine before returning to school. Students must also be vomiting/diarrhea free for 24 hours before returning to school.
- If your child has seen a physician and he has ordered antibiotics, please keep the child home for 24 hours after the antibiotics have been started.
