# B. AzMERIT Update – Mr. Tony Blackwell

Mr. Blackwell addressed the Governing Board to discuss the AzMERIT testing issues we experienced on Tuesday, April 5. Mr. Blackwell said we learned a lot from April 5, adding testing has continued throughout the district without issue.

On April 5, we had approximately 400 students trying to log in at or around the same time – creating long delays. On Tuesday, network traffic is typically heavy as updates are taking place. When he was alerted about the problems, he began making adjustments to try and remedy the situation. Unfortunately a backlog was created as things stacked up in the queue, which ultimately stopped everything. Once the problem was identified, an inadequate Router and insufficient bandwidth, he began shutting things down: streaming, daily usage, updates and other non-essentials. This allowed the system to recover and for testing to continue.

We are scheduled to have a new Router in July, this was planned and budgeted for prior to this incident. Our current Router is over 10 years old, we've simply outgrown it. We are also

slated for an upgrade with Cox for additional bandwidth; this too had been scheduled prior to this issue.

Next year, in advance of AzMERIT, the system will be subjected to a stress test to reveal weaknesses.

Ms. Fry confirmed with Tony, the issues we experienced were on our end, Mr. Blackwell confirmed this was true.

Ms. Sharp said she met with the Testing monitors from the sites to hear first-hand their thoughts and ideas as we try and navigate through AzMERIT testing. All agreed to review the test results, and then determine what if anything, to communicate. We are in a 'hold harmless' testing period; however, the results will be published. Ms. Sharp also advised Board Members some districts are testing with pencil and paper, we were not given that option.

Board Members thanked Mr. Blackwell.

  - 3. Facilities maintenance Support Restore SFB funding for building maintenance
  - 4. Technology and Curriculum resources
  - **5.** Early Childhood Education Restore Full Day Kindergarten; Support Preschool Programs (required for SPED preschool population)

Plus two additional topics for consideration:

- **6.** Restoration of 9<sup>th</sup> grade JTED funding for certification opportunities
- 7. Transportation Funding Update bus fleet, currently on four year replacement cycle, not adequate for aging fleet
