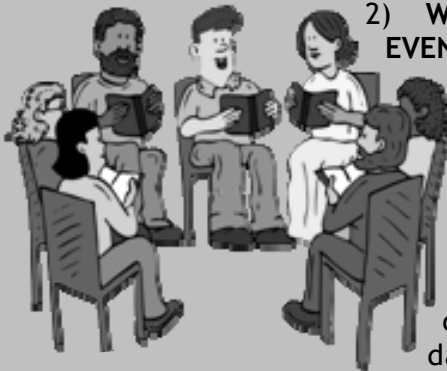
**ATTENTION: Young Adults from 21–39 (including couples)!**

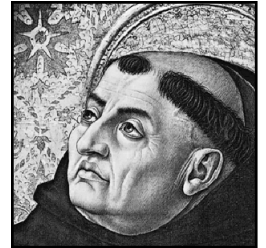
All those attending the Tridentine Mass next Sunday, November 8, are welcomed to come to the
