Notes From the Superintendent

The 3rd quarter grading period ended on Friday, March 13th, and report cards were issued on Friday, March 27, 2026. After reviewing the report card with your student, please contact your student's teacher(s) if you have any questions or concerns. The Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) computer-based testing for grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 will be administered April 6-17, 2026. Thank you to all our parents for your patience and support as we conduct these very important assessments.

At their regular March meeting, the Board of Education approved the District Calendar for the 2026-27 school year. The first day of student attendance will be Friday, August 14, 2026, which will be a 2:05 P.M. dismissal. We will have the entire week of Thanksgiving off next school year. The last day before Christmas break will be Tuesday, December 22, 2026, and school will resume Monday, January 4, 2027. Note that we will conduct E-Learning days in the event of a snow day so please be prepared to support your child on these days. Spring Break will be March 22-29, 2027, and coincides with Easter. The last day of student attendance will be Monday, May 24, 2027.

We hope you will have a chance to attend some of the district's other spring activities, junior high and high school track meets, baseball and softball games, music contests and concerts, and high school commencement.
