Hello Evaline Families and Friends. We've just wrapped up two of our favorite fall traditions — the pumpkin patch field trip and the Fall Festival party. Both events highlight Evaline's unique culture of family involvement



and community connection. It's always heartwarming to see parents and siblings joining our students at the pumpkin patch, taking part in the hayride, pumpkin picking, and exploring the corn maze together. Our Booster Club, made up of dedicated Evaline parents, organized the Fall Festival once again this year — planning games and contests for the kids and providing plenty of prizes. We were also joined by Cardinal Glass office staff, who served as judges for the costume and pumpkin-carving contests. This wonderful day of fun truly reflects the closeness between our school, our families, and our broader community. On the academic front, we're proud to share that last year's state test results placed Evaline at the top of Lewis County elementary schools in math performance, and second in language arts, with nearly 90% of students meeting grade-level expectations. Most of our graduates move on to Napavine Middle School, where they continue to excel — maintaining an average GPA of 3.25 in both Math and English Language Arts each quarter. It's rewarding to see our students thriving — enjoying enriching activities while achieving strong academic progress. Evaline truly is a wonderful place to learn and grow, and we're so grateful for the continued support of our community.


Scholarship Applications are due each May. Graduating High School Seniors who attended Evaline are encouraged to apply. Applications are available on our website and at the district office.
