State Assessment Schedule for Families 2023. Our mandated state assessments in science will be next Wednesday and Thursday for students in grades 5 and 8 only. Thank you in advance for ensuring students are well rested and have had breakfast prior to coming to school if they do not receive free school breakfast. This week concludes our state assessment testing. Thank you for your continued support.

Marching Band: Rehearsals continue after school on May 15th, and 22nd. Students need a <u>signed permission slip</u> and their instruments, and are required to wear closed-toed shoes to march after school. Rehearsals during the school day will continue on Wednesday: May 17th, and 24th. Students need their instruments and closed-toed shoes to march.

<u>Spongy Moths</u>: We have discovered the presence of the Spongy Moth caterpillar and our trees will soon be treated with ABACIDE -2 <u>https://mauget.com/products/abacide-2/</u>, a pesticide that is injected into the tree trunk. Since it is not a spray, there is no exposure to an individual's skin or respiratory system. The pesticide enters the veins of the tree leaves and the caterpillars are killed as they ingest the leaves and fall from the trees. We are expecting to treat trees on our campus this weekend.
