





STUDENTS TRANSFERRED & GRADUATED

The number of Pearl River Students who *transferred & graduated* from MS Universities has **increased 32%** since 2017.

State average is an increase of 3.2% since 2017.



TRANSFER STUDENTS GRADUATE WITH HIGHER GPA

Pearl River Community College students who transfer to Mississippi institutions of higher learning graduate from the university with an average GPA of 3.29, which is up from 3.03 in 2017.
