Minutes:

All members are present

- Report on Covid cases- - - Andrea
  - 2 cases since the last SHAC meeting and none currently
  
- Report on Immunizations- - - Isela for Elementary & Andrea for MS & HS
  - AES-Waiting on 1 student to turn in an exemption form
  - AMS-100%
  - AHS-100% (Have 1 coming up this spring who will be due to update their exemption form)
  - Will submit the yearly required report to Texas Department of State Health Services by Dec 9, 2022
  
- Report on Screenings- - - Andrea
  - Will be performing our required screenings December 13, 14, & 15
  - HVA on all PK, K, 1, 3, 5, 7 & all new students to the district
  - Spinal on all 5 & 7 girls and 8th grade boys
  
- AEDs- - - Andrea
  - School board approved a budget amendment to replace all of our old AEDs and to also add 5 new AEDs
  - Will also purchase 1 for the SRO to carry
  - Would like to purchase the Philips Heartsmart Onsite model. We currently have 1 at the Elementary. The company has a “stop ship” on them now and should be able to get them by January. This model is very simple and easy to operate.
  - The new SRO will also be carrying one in his police vehicle.
  
- Narcan- - - Andrea
  - We don't need a Rx. We would need to have a standing order to administer “as needed” just like with the EpiPen
  - Pharmacies in Texas are able to dispense Narcan if they have applied for a standing order and taken a 1 hour course.
  - Cost is between \$45-\$65 for a 2 dose box. Would need to order 1 for each campus and 1 for the SRO and 1 for the trainer (5 total for a total of \$225-\$325).
  - Add to student handbook for next year
  - Would need to train employees with CPR like we do with EpiPens
  - Not subject to criminal liability if acting in good faith with reasonable suspicion
  - Need to have a standard in place instructing staff on when and how to administer

- Will work on a written standard and an addition to the student handbook for next year
- We can add this to our standing orders for next year
- Administration voiced concern about the safety of the administration, parents being upset if we assumed that their student was taking an opioid and the perception of the school district if we implemented this
- Will talk to the administration during one of their admin meetings to inform them about the details to get their thoughts on continuing with this option
