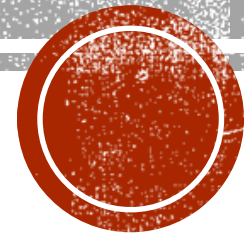

ESSER

- Provides federal funds to state and local educational agencies to help safely reopen and sustain the safe operation of schools and address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on the nation's students.



Safe Return Plan

- Strategies to minimize the risk of attending school
 - Mandated mask wearing with a parent opt-out
 - Rigorous cleaning protocols
 - Physical distancing to the maximum extent possible
 - Education concerning hand washing and respiratory etiquette
 - Updating HVAC systems
 - Passive screening upon entering buildings and facilities
 - Offering on-site vaccinations for faculty and staff
 - Working with the Marion County Health Department
 - Providing students with unique accommodations when needed



Safe Return Plan

- MCS response if Governor of Tennessee declares a state of emergency and schools are closed
 - Provide synchronous virtual instruction
 - Use of ZOOM and virtual academic programs
 - Provide devices and internet access for students that are in need
 - Counseling services will continue for individuals in need
 - Feeding sites will be utilized to provide breakfast and lunch during the closures

 - Cleaning Supplies
 - Foggers/Hand Sanitizer/Signage
 - Thermometers
 - Substitutes for high-risk educators

 - ZOOM Subscriptions
 - Classroom Technology (visual and audio)
 - Teacher Laptops
 - Student Chromebooks
 - Wi-Fi and infrastructure upgrades
- Virtual components of curriculum
 - New Literacy Programs
