

## **PLAY Card Resources**








As you scroll down you will find more types of resources.






A short video comes up to discuss Hoopla, as well as more information about the resource.




Not all resources have the Show Me green button tutorial, but be on the look out as several of our resources do.

Tutor.com also has the Show Me more button.




