The School Day is 7:50 a.m. to 2:55 p.m.

All Classes From PK3 through Grade 8 Begin Promptly at 7:50 am. Be sure to arrive at school no later than 7:50 so your child is ready to start on time! Late arrivals cause disruption and loss of learning time.

Doctor's Appointments

- Call school in advance to tell us about early pickups for doctor's appointments. Provide the school office with a doctor's note verifying the appointment.
- ♣ Early pick up for any other reason than a doctor's appointment requires meeting with the principal. It is important that students attend a full day of school from 7:50 a.m. to 2:55 p.m.

Early Pick Ups

- ♣ Early pickups at the end of the school day for any other reason than a verified medical appointment result in valuable lost learning time for your child—and cause disruption to the teacher and the learning of all other students in the classroom.
- If you come early and have not called in advance to let us know of a scheduled doctor's appointment, you will be asked to return to your car to wait.
- ♣ Trying to avoid the carline is not an acceptable reason for picking up early.
- Fridays are typically a full day of school. Getting a head start on the weekend is not an acceptable reason to pick up early.

Late Pick Up Penalty Fees

Parents are responsible to pick children up on time at the end of the school day. Carline is from 2:55-3:25. The following late fees are in effect for students picked up after 3:25:

- 3:30-4:00, \$15 per child for the first half-hour (or after the end of carline to 4:00 pm)
- 4:00-4:30, \$20 per child for the second half-hour
- 4:30 or later, \$20 per child per every additional half-hour
- On early dismissal days, late charges start at 2:00 p.m.

No Food from Outside Vendors in Cafeteria

Our participation in the National School Lunch and Breakfast program reflects our effort to provide healthy food choices and good nutrition. **Parents are asked not to bring competitive food such as fast food (including drinks) or food prepared by outside vendors into the school cafeteria for breakfast or lunch.** Breakfast and lunch are free for all students. Breakfast serving stops at 7:45. Children may bring a packed breakfast or lunch from home.

Student Birthdays

Families are asked to not bring balloons and gifts to school to be delivered to students during the school day. Such deliveries are disruptive to the classroom and are more appropriate to be given at home. Cupcakes and other sweets do not fit the guidelines of our School Wellness Policy and cannot be given out at school.
