3. Genesis: the first creation story 1:1 to 2:3
 - a. Creation is progressive: God is not in a hurry (this can be difficult!)
 - b. evening and morning the first day: the day begins at sunset
 - c. v.2 spirit n the face of the waters: ruach, pneuma
 - d. v. 6 firmament: the sky here thought to be a wall or a shell day 2
 - e. day 3, separating of the waters and creation of vegetation
 - f. day 4, creation of the stars and sun
 - g. 5th day: creatures: God commands the earth to produce stuff
 - h. 6th day: the animals
 - i. V 27: man in His own image, male and female
 - j. The world in then place in man's care: no fertility or storm gods
 - k. 2:1 God rests - and so should we
 1. This is the J source: contrast with 2:4 "the Lord God "Elohist")
4. The second creation
 - a. Here man is created first: note the breath; late the plants
 - b. Man is made the caretaker, not the ruler – note from the dust (ash)
 - c. Four great rivers, Tigris Euphrates Nile (Gihon) Pishion Ganges?)
