Assessments and Intervention Services

We will continue to use FastBridge for internal assessments this year for our K-6th years. This year we will be adding a math assessment for kindergarteners and we are required by Minnesota to use the Capti ReadBasix tool for any Upper Elementary child who tests below grade level on FastBridge reading. Families may not opt out of these assessments unless children have an IEP/IFSP designating as such, however we will notify you when they are taking place and will be happy to share results.

Children who received intervention services in math or reading this spring with Jessy and Megan, respectively, will continue to receive those services this fall until assessments are complete.

New Staff

At CMES, we are very excited to welcome Latricia Domally (Tricia) and EG Saathoff to our special education team this fall! Tricia will be serving as a Special Education Coordinator, helping with scheduling, meetings, supporting our on-site team, and providing some service to children. In addition, she will cover Emma's schedule until Emma returns from parental leave in mid-late October. EG is our new School Social Worker. They will also provide special education services, as well as supporting our social-emotional curriculum and providing social skills and behavior regulation groups to children without IEPs. We can't wait for you to meet both Tricia and EG at the Back to School Fair!

In our early childhood program, we are delighted to have Madelyn Avila Flores working in Children's House 2 alongside Kristin and Katte. With Maggie moving into the Toddler Community full-time, we expect that after care for Children's House will be supported with staff that the children currently know (exact details to come).
