2.	<p>Special Reports: Presentation of the plans for Colebrook School expansion Introduction: Brian LaPerle</p> <p>Brian welcomed the group and spoke of his excitement about bringing this board member group together – the first time this has occurred. He referenced the conclusion of the Connecticut River Collaborative Committee and his hope that this will be a new beginning – working together to achieve our long agreed upon goal – to have one high school in the region. Our goal is to be inclusive in our future planning for North Country secondary students and provide all members of our area school boards firsthand information concerning our vision and process, discuss ways that area board members and their respective communities can participate and provide input. We are one in our focus – to provide the best education to all high school students in the North Country.</p> <p>Representative of Lavallee and Brensinger Architects, recently contracted by Colebrook School District for design services, presented information. They shared their background and experiences in school construction in NH, noting successes and experience with high school and CTE projects. They noted we were at the beginning stages of planning and would be engaging students, school staff, and the community in the coming months as the project design unfolds. Questions from participants concerned the initiation of the project, the CTE component and how districts in the region would be able to participate.
