## School Tax Credit

Arizona Revised Statute 43-1089.01 allows an individual income tax credit for up to $\mathbf{\$ 2 0 0}$ or $\$ 400$ if filing jointly ( $\$ 200$ each if filing separate returns) for fees paid directly to Arizona public schools to support extracurricular activities. This is not a tax deduction -- it is a dollar-for-dollar tax credit.


An extracurricular activity is any schoolsponsored activity that requires enrolled students to pay a fee in order to participate. Generally, extracurricular activities are optional, non-credit, supplement the education program, and require students to pay a fee.


## Answers to Common Questions

To receive the tax credit for tax year 2014, you must send your payment to the school by December 31, 2014. Payments postmarked by December 31 will qualify.

You do not have to have a child in school to claim a tax credit. Individual taxpayers may claim the tax credit, but corporations may not.

This tax credit may not be used to reduce tax liability to less than zero (refund is not permitted if there is no tax liability). Example: If you owe only $\$ 150$ in state income tax, and you donate $\$ 200$ to extracurricular activities, you'll receive $\$ 150$ back when you file your tax return -- the credit cannot reduce your tax to minus $\$ 50$.
