

Shippensburg High School Child Development Free Nursery School Program



Shippensburg High School Child Development Nursery School program is a course offered at the high school for students at the high school and children in the community. High school students learn about the development of preschool aged children then apply their knowledge in a student run, teacher monitored nursery school program. Students provide a safe and nurturing environment for children to become familiar with preschool structure and enjoy activities and learning through play, stories and songs in addition to small and large group activities and play. There is no charge to articipate.

There are three- sessions throughout the year with about a four week break in between each session. A child can be registered for all or the desired sessions at one time. We also accept children throughout the year as they become old enough to join the program. Children who attend must be three, four or five years old. Other requirements include having their own transportation and the child must be completely toilet trained. The program runs four days a week, typically Tuesday - Friday, unless otherwise noted on specific session calendar. The time is from 8:55-10:15 AM. The program is available for 12 children in the community. Registration occurs on a completed forms received basis. Further information and contact will be available at Shippensburg High School, or by email to mParker@ship.k12.pa.us.

Physical can be from your doctor's office or a copy of driver license or permit. This is essential to graduate, walk the stage, and get your diploma. (If you already submitted in 11th grade or since the start of this school year please disregard.)

These are requirements from the state for graduation. Vaccine exemption forms are available, and I will provide one to you to sign if you are planning to not receive the recommended vaccines. 
