The event was created to help curtail crime in the Cities of Bellefontaine Neighbors, Moline Acrea and Spanish Lake.

The Summit consist of 38 local and state organizations in fields of; healthcare, home improvement, law-enforcement, emergency services, social justice, physical and mental health, employment unions and senior services. The safety summit is held each year on the second Saturday in October.

# **RGSD AWARDED PROJECT AWARE GRANT FOR MENTAL HEALTH**

The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education announced that Riverview Gardens School District is a recipient of the Missouri Project AWARE Grant. The grant will fund approximately \$350K per year towards mental health services, initiatives, personnel and resources from 2022-2026.

The grant is funded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services - Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration. It will help place social workers and counselors in schools to provide behavioral health services and programs. The funds will also be used to provide access to mental health and provide resources for students, staff and parents.

"We are excited to receive the Missouri Project AWARE grant," said Dr. Tanya Patton, assistant superintendent of Student, School & Community Support. "The funding will help Riverview Gardens provide critical mental health support, services and resources to the RGSD community."
