Step 1: Choose your Focus area (what are you interested in?) (bold heading in each box)

Step 2: What is the Program of Study that falls within my focus area? (marked in Red)

Step 3: What is the first course offered in that program of study?

Step 4: Is the level one course offered in the 9th grade at CCRA? (Blue highlight is offered at CCRA)

Step 5: If it is offered at CCRA then select that course as your 1st elective course.

Step 6: If it is not offered at CCRA then consider the alternate that is offered and select it.
