Cell Phone Policy

CELL PHONES AND SIMILAR ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED on school campus during school hours. Students are not allowed to have/use cell phones, beepers, or pagers during school hours. Electronic Devices (including cell phones) found in a student's possession shall be taken by staff and turned into the office. The student will be given a receipt of property for the device.

- 1st Offense – The parent will be allowed to pay a fine of \$25.00 to get the phone/electronic device back.
- 2nd Offense – The parent will be allowed to pay a fine of \$50.00 to get the phone/electronic device back.
- 3rd Offense – The parent may bring the receipt and pick up the electronic device at the end of the school year.
- Cell Phones not picked up within 30 days after school is out will be donated to the Sheriff's department.

On the first or second offense, if the student refuses to turn in the phone, the student will be placed in ISS until the phone is turned in or the fine is paid. On the third offense, the student will be placed in ISS until the phone is turned in.

Funds collected based on these fines will be put into the student activities fund for activities honoring students.
